### Prizes:

#### Open

First £1,000, Second £300, Third £150

Trophy for highest placed Shropshire-based player in the Open, plus Grading prize.

#### Major, Intermediate and Minor

First £300, Second £200, Third £100 plus Grading prizes.

If ties occur, prize money will be shared.

### Rate of Play

All moves in 90 minutes, plus 30 seconds per move from move one.

### Entry fees:

Open: Adult £35; Junior (U18) £25

Major and Minor: Adult £25; Junior (U18) £20

Additional late entry fee if received after  
22/12/17 - £5

ECF congress fee if not Silver/Gold/Platinum ECF member - £10.50

English players in the FIDE-rated Open are required to be Gold or Platinum ECF members.

Non English players must provide their FIDE Identification Number (FIN) at the time of entry. If you do not have an FIN, you must apply to your own federation for an FIN.

For Major, Intermediate and Minor section, ECF congress fee for entrants who are not Silver/Gold/Platinum ECF member - £7.50

Prizegiving will take place as soon as possible after round 5. Players may request a half-point bye in any one of the first three rounds at the time of entry.

## Venue & Refreshments

We are very grateful to the Wrekin Housing Trust who have allowed us the use of their excellent training suite and catering facilities for the event. Only refreshments purchased at the venue may be consumed on site and we ask all participants to support this policy. Smoking is not permitted at all on the site. The venue is just a few minutes from the M54 and Telford rail station.

## Late Arrival

Players arriving more than 30 minutes after the scheduled start of any round will record a loss by default, unless a suitable pairing can be arranged. Players whose opponents have not arrived 30 minutes after the start of a round, and players having a bye, will be re-paired if possible.

## Organisation

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry or transfer an entry to another section without giving a reason. Players accept as a condition of entry that the Organisers' and Controller's decision on any aspect of the congress is final, and that the information provided on the entry form may be recorded and used for congress administration, mailing lists and grading purposes. Under exceptional circumstances, at the organisers' discretion, prize fund can be reduced. Adverse weather conditions may force either cancellation of the congress, or your withdrawal from it. While we can make no guarantee, we will try to refund at least part of the entry fee. Mobile phones and other portable communication devices must be switched off for the duration of play with the penalty for non-compliance being a default for that game.
